



BAITS TAKEN DURING A 1080 POISONING PROGRAM TARGETING DINGOES



Birds, lizards, kangaroos topped the list of non-targets. For every bait taken by a dingo on that project:



84 were taken by other species.









About 1080 poison

- one thousand and eightieth (1080th) chemical trialed by scientists in WW2
- white, odourless and tasteless
- no known antidote
- most toxic category (World Health Org.)
- chemical of "security concern" (Aus.)
- lethal to all lifeforms

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When Compound 1080 first appeared in the 1940s it was hailed as a miracle and a wonder, a rat control marvel without precedent, and the best predator poison ever invented. Only a few decades later 1080 was being denounced as one of the worst evils ever perpetrated by modern science.

Australia and New Zealand world-leading users of 1080. Banned in most other countries. Toxic to all life forms. PLUS, as a victim eaten by another animal:



1080 is a food chain killer




Easily available anti-coagulant poisons people use: rabbit, mouse and rat poisons, are similarly food chain killers, e.g. Pindone

You can see how dogs, cats, birds, lizards and herbivores are attracted to these baits



Bait materials





Ground baiting

Baits are laid on the ground by hand or buried along tracks and fence lines.

Baits can remain lethal for several months.

No way. Dogs/canines and other victims at risk of prolonged, painful and violent death.

- It can take between two hours and two weeks for death to occur and between 30 minutes and 20 hours for first signs of vomiting, anxiety and shaking leading to extreme distress and seizures.
- It you saw the film Red Dog or know someone whose dog took a 1080 bait you will know the prolonged agony the animal goes through. Strychnine poisoning, similar effects. From a dog or fox perspective, it's a myth that 1080 is more humane.

30 dogs die: baits moved by birds the serial killer?

• Forget murder conspiracy: crows the probable culprit in dog deaths

In the West Australian goldfields, some people believe crows may have unwittingly killed 30 pet dogs since August.

Can a bird kill a dog? In the far northern reaches of the West Australian goldfields, some people are beginning to believe crows may have unwittingly killed 30 pet dogs since August.

The poisoning deaths have shocked a small town of 300 people, 1000km northeast of Perth.

Retired mechanic Jack Long, whose beloved alsatian Bear was among the victims, believes this is the work of an unknown villain who also targeted two dogs owned by a local police officer, a barmaid's puppy, a dog owned by the shire president's daughter and some owned by Aboriginal families from a housing estate called The Village.

But police in Laverton have found no evidence of a serial dog killer. Instead, they think the deaths could be linked to the arrival of a murder of crows that "turned the sky black" nine weeks ago, before Laverton's dogs began to die. The extraordinary theory is that crows had swallowed baits meant for wild dogs in the bush then regurgitated them in town, where pet dogs found them.
